

RIFLE SECTION

Range Rules

1. The "RANGE OPEN", "RANGE CLOSED" sign must be utilized. Please "OPEN" the range as you enter (if you are the first person in) and "CLOSE" the range as you leave (if you are last person out).
2. No alcoholic beverages are permitted on club property.
3. Both EYE and EAR protection are "MANDATORY" when on the range.
4. If more than one person is using the range, "ONE" person MUST act as Range Officer and must be obeyed at all times.
5. On "Cease Fire" or "Range Closed" all firearms must be made safe (unloaded, magazine out & actions open), removed from firing line and placed in the racks. All persons must stand clear of the firing line when personnel are down range.
6. Upon the "Range Open" command, all firearms must be pointed down range when not in the racks.
7. Do not shoot cross range. Shoot only at the target boards specified on each shooting bench.
8. Do not shoot at anything except targets which are properly attached to the "interior" of the target boards. This minimizes damage to the support frames. No objects are to be placed on top of the target frames. No pop cans or other makeshift targets are allowed.
9. The exception to paper targets is the approved "GONG" at 200 yards. No Magnums or Military ball ammunition is to be fired at the gong.
10. The RIGHT side of the range is restricted to SILHOUETTE SHOOTING with .22 rimfire ammunition "ONLY". The left side of the range is open to all calibres including .22 rimfire.
11. Do not shoot shotguns at target frames. A special shotgun target is provided for your use.
12. Section membership ID cards must be worn at all times and produced when requested.
13. Members are allowed only 2 guests at one time. Guests are the responsibility of the host member, who must accompany the guest at all times.
14. Members must close and lock the entrance gate behind them when entering and leaving the property. (Keys are available upon executive approval.)
15. The range must be left in a clean and orderly condition.
16. All Federal, Provincial and Municipal laws and regulations must be followed while on club property.

17. The use of "RESTRICTED" or "PROHIBITED" firearms is not allowed on the rifle range.

18. Magazines are restricted to five rounds and "RAPID FIRE" is not allowed.

19. All section members are requested to participate in range projects such as spring clean-up, range improvements and maintenance. Prior notice will be given for such events. Please remember that our club operates on a volunteer basis and as such your support and assistance will be appreciated.
